

Tokyo expands Children's Smile Spot™ baby care facilities at Daimon Station on the Toei Subway

From **Monday, March 9, 2026**, the **Tokyo Metropolitan Government (TMG)** will be expanding its **Children's Smile Spot™** baby care facility to **Daimon Station**.

TMG has been developing Children's Smile Spot™ facilities to support outings with babies and young children at **Ueno-Okachimachi, Shinjuku Nishiguchi, and Monzen-Nakacho Station** on the Toei Oedo Line.

The Children's Smile Spot™ at Daimon Station will offer **vending machines selling baby care products such as liquid infant formula and disposable diapers**, as well as a **stroller rental service**, making it easier for travelers with small children to move around the city.

Through these initiatives, TMG aims to create an environment in which families with young children can more easily use public transportation, while also fostering a society that supports child-rearing as a whole.




The facility is also accessible by elevator from Daimon Station on the Toei Asakusa Line.
